## SAVE International Certified Value Methodology Fundamentals 2 (VMF 2) Training Course.

Completion of a 32-hour duration VMF 2 training course is one of the requirements for CVS<sup>®</sup> (Certified Value Specialist) certification through SAVE International.

The VMF 2 course moves beyond the basics of the VMF 1 Value Methodology (VM) training through the remaining 4 of 9 core competencies, as well as elaboration on the previous 5 core competencies addressed in the pre-requisite VMF 1 course.

Participants need to be able to draw on applied VM experience since participating in the VMF 2 course. The SAVE International Certification Board requires the seminar to be conducted in a manner that encourages and emphasizes active participant interchange and comparisons of personal experiences.

Discussions are facilitated so that participants draw their own conclusions about what is appropriate to their particular situations, as well as understand how the Value Methodology works in environments with which they may not be familiar.

- ❖ To enable project delivery specialists to save time and money on projects without sacrificing required function
- ❖ To build on knowledge already acquired through participating in VMF 1 training and experience gained in subsequent VA/VE applications

**Extracts from SAVE International Core Competency Education Objectives and Testing Parameters for VMA<sup>SM</sup> and CVS<sup>®</sup>:** “Core Competency Testing Objectives for Value Methodology Associate (VMA<sup>SM</sup>) and Certified Value Specialist (CVS<sup>®</sup>) assume that the VMA<sup>SM</sup> exam and CVS<sup>®</sup> exam are now separate tests, where a CVS<sup>®</sup> examinee has previously passed the VMA exam. CVS<sup>®</sup> examinees must receive approval\* to take the CVS exam and must be currently certified as a VMA<sup>SM</sup>. The Value Methodology Fundamentals 1 (VMF 1) course covers all information required to pass the VMA<sup>SM</sup> exam.

The Value Methodology Fundamentals 2 (VMF 2) course covers additional information required to pass the CVS<sup>®</sup> exam.

NOTE: \*Assumes VMA<sup>SM</sup>s participate as value team members and CVS<sup>®</sup>'s facilitate.”

### Certification Program Transition

“The Value Methodology Associate (VMA<sup>SM</sup>) level is the introductory qualification to the Value Methodology. This level of competency is for VA/VE team members and should provide a solid understanding to contribute to a value study.

The Certified Value Specialist<sup>®</sup> (CVS<sup>®</sup>) core competencies contain a broader range of skills necessary to plan, organize, lead and bring results to a VA/VE study. It is required that a CVS<sup>®</sup> conduct a Value Methodology Fundamentals 1 (VMF 1) course for VMA<sup>SM</sup> certification and lead all studies for CVS<sup>®</sup> initial certification application. **The CVS<sup>®</sup> is the only one qualified and approved by SAVE standards to facilitate a value study. The VMA<sup>SM</sup> can assist the CVS<sup>®</sup> in charge, but is not, by core competencies definition, qualified to lead VA/VE studies.”**

### VMF 2 Course Pre-Requisite

**“A VMF 2 course candidate must participate in a minimum of two value studies (a minimum of 24 hours each) following completion of the VMF 1 course”.**
